In the paper “Measuring the Longitudinal Evolution of the Online Anonymous Marketplace Ecosystem” by Kyle Soska and Nicolas Christin, *Carnegie Mellon University* (Monday session “Measurement: We Didn’t Start the Fire,” pp. 33–48 of the proceedings), two numbers were incorrectly reported.

1. On page 40, instead of “US Government calculations of \$189M,” the text should read “US Government calculations of \$214M.” Furthermore, the paragraph should end with “These calculations were presented during the trial of the Silk Road founder (evidence GX940).”

2. On page 47, the text in the conclusion reading “up to \$700,000 daily” should instead be “up to \$650,000 daily.”
